


## Easy PJs Pattern



Enlarge this pattern 640 percent or until the squares measure 1 inch. Lengthen or shorten the pattern on the double lines.



## To alter this pattern for children:

- Subtract the child's hip or waist measurement, whichever is larger, from the pattern's size A hip/waist measurement.
- 2. Fold the pant pattern vertically, parallel to the grainline. Fold out half the circumference difference (from step 1). This establishes the pants' circumference.
- 3. Have the child sit on a hard chair, and measure vertically from the seat to the waist. Add 1 inch to this crotch depth measurement. Shorten the pattern to make the distance between the upper edge and crotchline equal this measurement plus 1½ inches.
- 4. Measure the child's inseam. Shorten the pattern where marked so the distance from the crotchline to the hem foldline equals this length.
